

Math Placement Options and Guidelines (effective May 1, 2024)

These placement options are used if the student does not have transfer courses, dual credit courses, or AP test scores.

Placement by Math ACT/SAT scores

- Official test scores must be on file and posted in PAWS. You cannot enroll without this information.
- Math sub score must be shown on submitted scores.
- Specific score placement information is available in the chart to the right.

ALEKS Placement Test Information

- A student has the opportunity to improve their initial math placement through completion of ALEKS modules targeted on areas of needed improvement after testing.
- A student will have up to 5 opportunities to improve their math placement.
- Required minimum scores are provided in the chart to the right.
- Incoming freshman will receive an email or letter with placement information. Continuing students will need to contact their advisor.
- Placement by ALEKS is valid for two academic years.

¹Students who need MAT 1070 with MAT 1270 will enroll on MAT 1070 only. The Department of Mathematics and Computer Science will enroll the student in the associated MAT 1270. Enrolling in MAT 1070 will block off the needed time for both classes.

²Students who need MAT 1020 with MAT 1420 will enroll on MAT 1020 only. The Department of Mathematics and Computer Science will enroll the student in the associated MAT 1420. Enrolling in MAT 1020 will block off the needed time for both classes.
