VI. Executive Director's Report

2. NCATE review and report timelines. Dean Jackman, Dr. Bower, and Dr. Fewell presented information regarding the NCATE review, which is scheduled for Fall 2009. Dr. Bower and Dr. Fewell will be the main contacts for questions. The timeline that will be followed for this review is as follows:
 - a. Fall 2007 – review status of SPAs and requirements; review conceptual framework; in-service with faculty related to dispositions/accreditation/conceptual framework; work with graduate programs for assessment/dispositions integration.
 - b. Spring 2008 – work with SPA reports to make sure report drafts are completed by the end of the semester; September 15, 2008 (or before) SPA reports are due to NCATE.
 - c. 2009 – institutional report rough draft due Spring 2009; final report due to NCATE 60 days prior to fall visit.
