
² The graduate learning goals include: a depth of content knowledge, critical thinking and problem solving, advanced scholarship through research or creative activity, and oral and written communication skills.

³ The graduate program in English had a mature assessment program last year with all Level 3s, they were not required to submit a report this year (information from 2011 report)



Percentage of EIU Graduate Programs Adopting Graduate Learning Goals




Percentage of A&H Graduate Programs Adopting Graduate Learning Goals

- All A&H graduate programs are assessing all 4 graduate learning goals
- 2005 NCA visitors stated that the departmental assessment plans appear uneven in their collection and use of relevant data to support student learning. Self-study for 2015 NCA visit will begin in 2012
 - EIU Graduate Programs Summer 2006 - 48% were at level 3 with objectives, 24% with measures, 17% with expectations, 3% with results, 21% with the feedback loop
 - EIU Graduate Programs Summer 2011- 86% were at level 3 with objectives, 50% with measures, 54% with expectations, 46% with results, 68% with the feedback loop
- Components of all plans in A&H rated as a 2 or 3, however A&H grad programs behind university average for percentage at level 3 (mature plans) for objectives, measures, results and feedback
- Plans cannot reach a level three designation in measures until they use both direct and indirect measures and employ multiple measures of assessment. Reaching level three for results takes time; programs must display several years of collection and analysis of data and use data for program improvement in order to reach level 3 for the results section of the plan
