CTE/FCS major needs changed to better reflect the FCS major course changes for fall 2014.

The CTE program committee meeting 12-11-2014 discussed the deletion of the current CTE/FCS requirement of FCS 1000, FCS 2000, and FCS 3000 as they will no longer be offered. Members voted to insert the current core of FCS 2500 course, but felt that the FCS 3500 course prepares students for their FCS major’s internship was not appropriate course for CTE/FCS. They decided to insert and FCS elective course beyond the required core courses.
