Use ChatGPT for writing


Design a lesson plan

-  Ask ChatGPT to write a lesson plan for a new unit or topic.
-  Ask the bot to compose an series of scaffolded assessments.
-  ChatGPT can help organize content for presentation slides.
-  Ask ChatGPT to generate simplified explanations of difficult topics.
-  Generate engaging, higher-order prompts for class discussions.
-  Create examples of concepts or ideas for student research projects.
-  Generate responses to common student questions or emails.
-  Create a bank of test questions with answer options.
-  Compose an analytic, holistic, or developmental rubric.
-  Generate feedback comments and create a comment bank for assignments.
-  Create examples or samples for students to compare against their own work.
-  Create project-based learning scenarios anchored in local and authentic contexts.
-  Generate scenarios for case studies or application of particular processes.
-  Use ChatGPT to bounce ideas off of for when designing a new course or new learning module.
