

Graduate Study Options for EIU Seniors

Reserved Graduate Credit and Graduate Courses for Undergraduate Credit

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To apply to take graduate-level courses for Reserve Graduate Credit or for use as Undergraduate Credit:

- the student must have completed at least **90** semester hours (Senior classification) of undergraduate coursework at time of application.
- the student must have a **cumulative GPA of 2.75** or higher.

SUBMISSION PROCESS

- Applications for Reserve Graduate Credit, or to apply graduate courses to a student's undergraduate degree, must be signed and approved on or before the deadline (as published in the academic calendar) to add courses for the semester.
- This form is not complete until it has been signed by the course instructor, UG advisor and the Graduate School Dean, and if necessary, the Graduate Coordinator.

NOTE: No undergraduate student, regardless of classification or GPA, may enroll in any graduate course numbered 6000 and above. This requirement may not be waived or appealed.
