2021 (FY2022) Impact Grants

EIU Student Impact Grants for Faculty Mentors are available again this year. Each award of \$1,500 is intended to support faculty who engage in high impact mentoring practices. Full time faculty (Unit A or B) who will be mentoring at least one student during the 2021 - 2022 academic year are eligible. Eligibility is biennial, i.e., no one is eligible for two consecutive years.

Applications are due to the Office of Research and Sponsored Programs by noon on

2021 IMPACT GRANTS

The purpose of the Impact Grants is to support faculty who engage in high impact mentoring practices. High impact practices include, but are not limited to, projects intended to result in publications with student co-authors, partnerships with local community organizations or schools, public displays of research and/or new creative works, and other projects that lead to external recognition of EIU.

These grants are more limited in scope than are grants from the Council for Faculty Research (CFR). Student Impact Grants must be used to support both students and faculty members. Up to ten awards will be funded for \$1,500 each.

Full time faculty (Unit A or B) who will be mentoring at least one undergraduate or graduate student during the 2021 - 2022 academic year are eligible. Eligibility is biennial, i.e., no one is eligible for two consecutive years.
