Qualities of Honors Faculty at Eastern Illinois University

An ideal Honors Faculty member at Eastern Illinois University should have ...

- Two years of teaching experience;
- Established an interest in the mission of the Honors College and Honors education;
- A clear understanding how their teaching philosophy enhances the mission of the Honors College;
- Participated in Faculty Development activities;
- A record of experience in their field of expertise as demonstrated by postgraduate study, professional experience, research/scholarship/creative activity in the discipline or service to the academic discipline;
- Evidence of interest in integrative classroom activities, including, but not limited to, interdisciplinarity, integration of academic work with the personal and/or professional development of the student, and reflection;
- An earned graduate degree appropriate for the discipline; terminal degrees are required for those mentoring department honors research and thesis experiences;
- Exhibited a commitment to mentoring;
- Approval/recommendation of the department chair, the Dean of the Honors College, and the Honors Council.
