<p>Introductions and Updates by schools</p>	<p>Dave, IHEC – symposium on social media in January</p> <p>Lewis University campus SAVE act on website; current programs: stress management, Red Flag campaign, bystander, Peer Ed and Student Advisory; wellness community overseeing smoke free for fac/staff; very busy with student sore so in the last three years with student counseling; working with athletes, 2nd year, with aod education using Peer Ed, MI via Poll Everyone, creating new team culture, AD is on board; working on grant for CHOICES; partnering with UPD wanting to be involved in prevention, late night programming; bystander intervention follow up with athletes, train-the-trainer; BR wrapping up; using Haven in fall; E-chug for sanctions has new substance abuse component; policy changes with sanctioning levels and consistency.</p> <p>Rock Valley College Working on electronic process for tracking VAWA training; Red Flag campaign; Smoke Free campus task force I place by December 31, 2014; working on marketing that; success counseling financial and academic; working on BR; Wellness Wednesdays – experts speaking on mental health and other topics monthly.</p> <p>Moraine Valley Community College The Most program a work program, nonstudents; prayer and meditation room is highly utilized, need more space; have a lactation room for everyone; veteran’s resource room with computers and printers; HIV testing for World AIDS Day, 1 + out of 26 tests. Alcohol Wise given to 300 students in College introduction courses – not mandated pilot program, added a substance abuse module, consent and respect – incentive was grade; Core data, IR assisting on how to use data to inform programming; BR is finished and looks great! Web assisted tobacco cessation program is successful, email blasting to promote. Smoke free campus – no discipline plan in place yet. PD issue fines; smoking cessation classes by Cook Co HD for employees first , then students Courage to Quit; second hand smoke education as well. counselors are trained for domestic violence and many for substance abuse; One is Too Many campaign and “It’s On Us”; Bystander program Bass Schuler to meet with Title IX; skits “the Hook UP” and “Sex Signals”; using Rice and Peterson cases to spark conversations with athletes, 60 attended. Ecalc for student athletes led by 4 counselors, needs a good assessment tool; in discussions about health promotion and aod coordinator; difficult semester for mental health and personal counseling; mental health awareness week: art fair, readings and classes.</p> <p>Joliet Junior College removing “wellness” from job title; tons of union grievances via student activities, Title IX coordinator and health/fitness center, creating a task force to bring groups together, identify purpose, mental health or alcohol; smoke free campus messages out by spring break,</p>

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	<p>cessation classes and Quitline up over summer; Domestic Violence coordinator rewriting policy, No More campaign, Bystander StepUp once a semester using Peer Ed; Will Co. HD doing HIV testing and screening for high risk men, drug users; Safe Zone program hosting annual drag show for World AIDS Day.</p> <p>Prairie State College BR in works, thinking about 2 yr goals; smoke free task force – go with law to go beyond and ban car smoking; inquired about Legacy grant; online assessment programs for alcohol and marijuana; having issues with Core; using Retention Alert – tracks and monitors students early intervention (StarFish is similar), academic and behavioral.</p>
<p>Dave's presentation</p> <p>Additional discussion topics</p>	<p>on effective prevention and scare tactics; sparked discussion about VAWA and awareness campaigns and the hope that there will be a study in their effectiveness in the next few years; increase of reporting, then hopefully a leveling of reporting – effective?</p> <p>Getting admin buy in – importance of CC and prevention programs; need a “Dear Colleague” for Alcohol Programming</p> <p>Faculty Gatekeepers of student issues – not making anyone aware of student problems until a crisis occurs; online reporting tool not being used or faculty not taking responsibility.</p>
