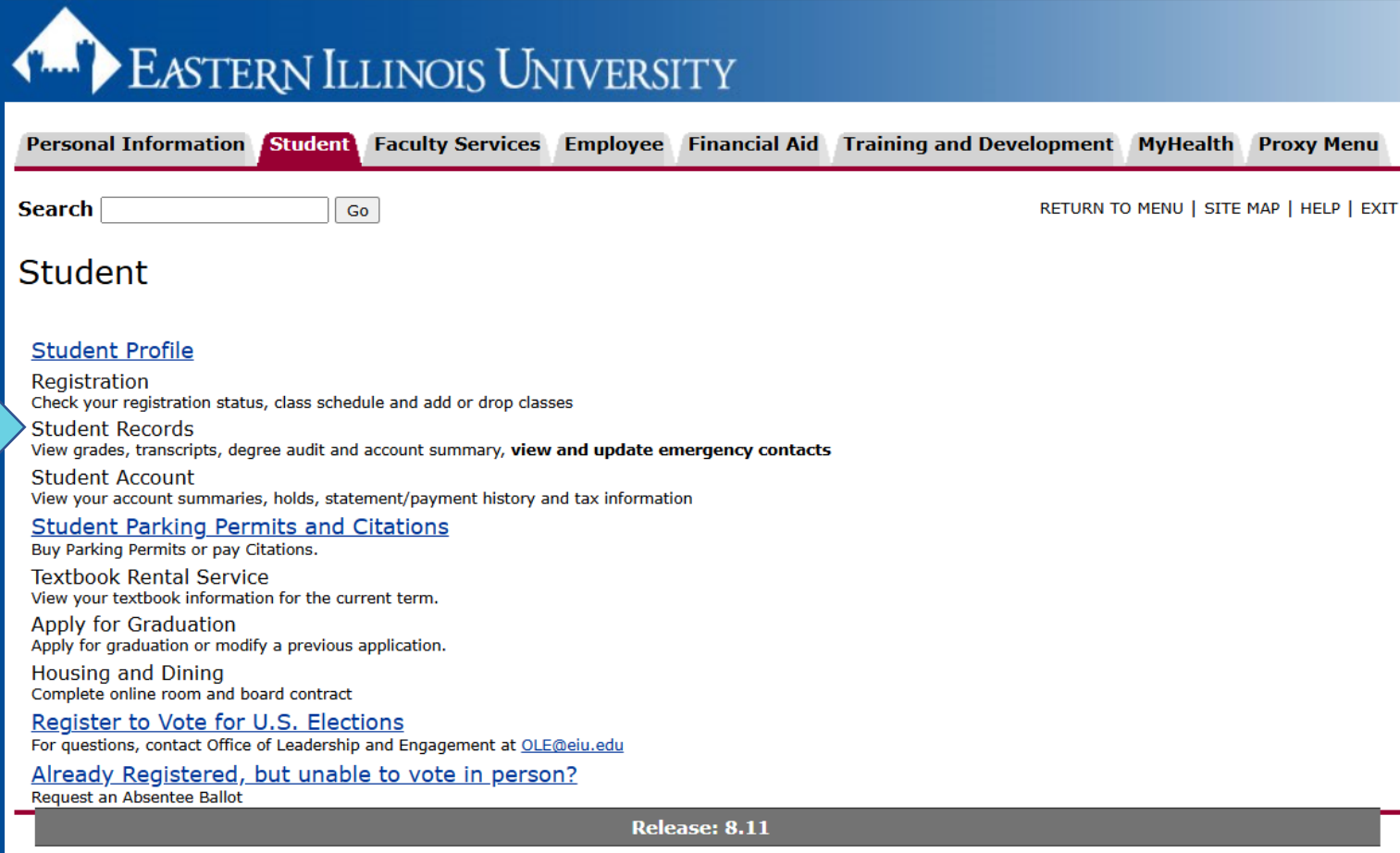
A tool to help you track and understand your degree requirements.

To be eligible for a degree with distinction, you must have completed at least 56 hours of coursework at EIU, including at least 40 hours of graded courses exclusive of work taken on the Credit/No Credit Option.

40 Hours in Upper-Division Coursework	Still needed:	You must earn at least 40 hours in 3000-4000 level courses. You currently have 21 hours applied, including in-progress. You still need a minimum of 19 additional upper-division hours.
25 Hours - EIU Residency Requirement	Still needed:	You must earn at least 25 hours from EIU. You currently have 23 hours applied, including in-progress. You still need a minimum of 2 additional hours.
