Senate Bill 18-19-07

Formation of a Judicial Research Committee

BE IT ENACTED, that the Eastern Illinois University Student Government approves the formation of a Judicial Research committee to begin the process of bringing back the Judicial Branch of student government. This committee shall consist of, but not be limited to, one Student Government executive member, 3-5 students who can be a combination of student senators and non-senators. The Student Government Association will also recognize Student Vice President of Academic Affairs Carson Gordon as the chair of this committee. The task of this committee is to research the judicial systems of other institutions and also the viability of one at Eastern Illinois University. From this information the committee will create job descriptions and a plan for establishing a Judicial Selection committee in the fall to fill the empty seats.

Rationale: Whereas the Judicial Branch of Student Government is outlined in the constitution as a crucial component of Student Government, and the Judicial Branch has fallen out of existence, the Student Government Association needs to begin the process of filling the open seats on the Judicial Branch.
